



Jan Bowers, PG, served as Executive Director of Chester County Water Resources Authority (1996-2019) and Director of Chester County Department of Facilities (2019-2023). While with the Authority, she led operation and management of the County's four regional flood control facilities and Chambers Lake regional water supply reservoir, and oversaw the Chester County / U.S. Geological Survey cooperative water resources programs.

Jan led development of Chester County's water resources management plan "*Watersheds*" and "*County-wide Act 167 Stormwater Management Plan*", and led implementation and adoption of the County-wide stormwater management ordinance. She co-coordinated multi-municipal watershed management partnerships for collaborative MS4 stormwater efforts, and worked with water suppliers on source water protection efforts. Jan provided floodplain management and National Flood Insurance Program mapping coordination, and led the local coordination for removal of the Brandywine Dam.

As Facilities Director, she managed operations, maintenance and capital improvement programs for the County's portfolio of operating and historic buildings, parks, regional trails, wastewater plant, and parking facilities. She is a licensed professional geologist in PA, DE and VA, a Past President (national) of the American Water Resources Association, and a graduate of West Virginia University and Catawba College (NC). Jan continues to reside in the Brandywine Creek Watershed since her retirement in 2023.
