Kevin is an expert in the full lifecycle of green stormwater programs, including planning, policy development, design, construction, operations and maintenance, asset management, and applied research. He has managed and contributed to projects in Pennsylvania, Maryland, Illinois, New Jersey, New York, and Washington, DC.

Kevin was a lead author of Philadelphia's Stormwater Management Guidance Manual, Green Stormwater Infrastructure As-Built Survey and Drafting Manual, and Green Stormwater Infrastructure Maintenance Manual. He also contributed to the Water Environment Federation's *Urban Stormwater Controls Operation and Maintenance* publication.

A longtime volunteer for professional and industry organizations, Kevin is a Board Member of the Community Design Collaborative in Philadelphia and Past Chair of the ASCE EWRI National Sustainable Stormwater Infrastructure Committee, among other activities.
